

TENDER NOTICE

Inviting Companies/Firms for Rate Contracting of Drug Sodium Antimony Gluconate

Attention :- Pharmaceutical Companies or their Authorised C & F Agents

Project Description

State Health Society Bihar is implementing the National Vector borne Diseases Control Program under NRHM to carry out necessary correction in the treatment of Kala-azar Patients. The Goal of the Program is to provide complete treatment to Kala-Azar patients in the State Shortage of good quality drugs in the government health institutions, the SHSB is aiming towards rational drug management and procurement, so as to ensure good quality drugs.

Tender bid is invited from interested Companies/Firms/Manufactures/Direct Importers/Authorised C&F Agents/Sole Distributors for *'Rate Contracting of (30ml multidose vials) Sodium Antimony Gluconate.*

(1) Minimum Eligibility Criteria: Bidders should meet the following criteria's to be eligible for bidding:

- A minimum annual turnover of Rs 25 Crores in the last three consecutive years.
- A market standing of minimum 3 years for the drug issued by the licensing authority of the concerned state.
- WHO-GMP/GMP (Good Manufacturing Practice)
- GLP (Good Laboratory Practice) certification
- Pan Card
- Income tax clearance certificate
- Income tax assessment report for the last 3 years
- Sales Tax clearance certificate.
- A demonstrated ability of handling large scale manufacturing
- Experience of supplying drugs for large scale requirements
- Bidders will be required to deposit **Rs. 25,000/-** security/tender money in the form of demand draft favoring **Executive Director, State Health Society Bihar**, as EMD.

(2) Submission Requirements: Interested companies/firms, wishing to bid, may submit in a large envelop marked "Tender bid for Rate Contracting of Sodium Antimony Gluconate". In separate sealed envelops-Cover 'A' for technical bid and Cover 'B' for rate/financial bid. If both financial and technical

bids are received in the same envelop, the tender bid shall be automatically rejected.

The company/firms is required to respond with each of the following:

Cover 'A' –

- License of the product quoted with latest license renewal certificate
- Minimum three years market standing for the drug issued by the licensing authority of the concerned state.
- Minimum annual turnover of Rs. 50 Lakhs in the last three years with details
- Last three years audited annual report
- GLP certificate
- WHO-GMP/GMP certificate
- Income tax clearance certificate
- Sales Tax clearance certificate
- Sales Tax clearance certificate
- Income tax assessment report for the last 3 years
- Copy of PAN card
- EMD in the form of demand draft of **Rs. 5,000** favouring **Executive Director, State Health Society Bihar**

Please Note: Any bid not accompanied by earnest money or any of the above mentioned documents will be automatically rejected.

Cover 'B'- Printed sheet with a landed price/basic rate excluding Local Sales Tax, then rates for taxes applicable and then the final rate, (the tendere is strictly prohibited to change/alter specification or unit size in the printed sheet & the rate per unit (landed price) will be the criteria for each item for effecting supplies within 10 days from the date of order should be given in the printed format.

An affidavit has to be given in this envelop that the rate quoted by the agency in the Financial bid is less than the MRP. In case the quoted price in the financial bid is not less than the MRP, it will not be accepted.

You are requested to clearly indicate each of the submission requirements mentioned in Cover A and Cover B along with the relevant page number in your Cover Letter/application accompanying the technical proposal.

(3) Tender Conditions :-

- (a) The vials shall have the logogram of Govt. of Bihar
- (b) The cap of the bottle shall not have the name of the manufacturer
- (c) Samples of supplies in each batch will be chosen for testing by Government of Bihar notified laboratories.

- (d) Liquidated damages will be levied for delayed supply (0.5% per day subject to a maximum of 15%)
- (e) Minimum expiry period of the products should not be less than 1½ years from the date on which the store receives the product, provided if the shelf life of the drug is 1½ years only, the above condition shall be reduced to 1 year.
- (f) If the product fails in quality test, the entire batch will be taken back by the supplier at the supplier's cost and the Government shall not be responsible for any damage during this period.
- (g) The medical officer in-charge of medical stores in the districts shall call drawing samples of each drug from each batch by the drug inspector. The drug inspector shall proceed as per the provisions of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules, 1945 if the sample drawn does not pass the test.
- (h) Leaked, soiled, broken containers with damaged labels shall not be accounted for the purpose of supply.
- (i) The inner label as well as label on the catch cover/carton shall bear conspicuously the words "BIHAR GOVERNMENT SUPPLY-NOT FOR SALE" and bolder than those already printed on the label. The above caption shall run from the lower left hand corner to the top right hand corner.
- (j) If the awarded supplier is unable to meet to fully supply at the L1 rate, the award can be given to other bidders at L1 rate by the Govt.
- (k) 3D multi-coloured self-adhesive hologram as approved by the GOB/SHSB should be used on the packing of the products.
- (l) The rate contract will be applicable for one year from the date of award of the contract.

(4) Deadline for Submission of Proposals

The technical and financial bids, in separate sealed envelopes, may reach the office of the undersigned latest by **5.00 PM** on or before 23.10.2007 by through/Registered/Speed-Post only. Bids received after this time, would not be entertained.

(5) Opening of Bids – Technical bid shall be opened in the presence of bidders or their authorized representative who desire to be present, and would thereafter be evaluated. Financial bid of only those tenderers will be opened whose technical bid is found eligible by the Technical Core Committee for Drug Purchase after inspection of the manufacturing premises in the case of drugs.

(6) For information of the Bidders – The list of L1 bidders for the drugs will be finalized at the State Health Society Bihar. After being awarded the contract, the awardees will be required to be registered with the Bihar Sales Tax. The Firms will be required to supply drugs to the Districts. The Civil Surgeon of the districts will place the order as per the requirement.

The SHSB would only rate contract as per the drug list advertised.

The selected Company/Firm will be immediately informed about the final award. In case the selected company/firm declines to take-up the task henceforth from SHSB at the quoted and approved rates. It would be barred from applying for any tender from the State Health Society Bihar. Also the tender/security money will not be reimbursed. The decision of the State Health Society Bihar shall be final, and no enquiries, or application for review, shall be entertained. The State Health Society Bihar reserves the right to cancel or reject any bid without assigning any reason.
