

7 Proceeding of the Technical Committee Meeting On Indelible Ink Marker Pens

Background: Indelible Ink Marker Pens are used during Pulse Polio Round to mark on the finger nail of the Immunized Children to see whether the child has been immunized or not. A tender notice was published for rate contracting of Indelible Ink Marker Pens in the Newspaper namely: Dainik Jagaran (Bihar Edition), Hindustan Times (All India Edition), Times of India (Patna Edition), The Hindu (Chennai Edition). The eligibility criteria and tender details were also uploaded on SHSB web site: <http://www.statehealthsocietybihar.org>. Till the last date for submission of tender, total 3 tenders were received.






Meeting of Technical Committee was held on its pre scheduled date 16.03.2011 to open and evaluate the Technical Bid received from the following three bidders.

1. **Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd**, 104, Sasco Bhawan, Azadpur Commercial Complex, Azadpur Delhi-110033.
2. **Milan Stationers**, Exhibition Road, Patna.
3. **Kores, Kores(India) Limited**, Chhaya "D" Block, Khaderan Singh Marg, Kadamkuan, Patna

Members present in the Technical Committee meeting were:-

Technical Bids of the bidders were opened in the meeting and cover envelops containing the technical bid as well as the bid itself was duly signed by the members and by the representative of two bidder namely **Kores (India), Ltd.** and **Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd** were present in the meeting. Bidder of **Milan Stationers** was informed telephonically but they show inability to attend the meeting. Hence, technical bids were opened in the presence of members of technical committee & authorized representative of **Kores (India), Ltd.** and **Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd.**

A Technical comparative chart was prepared in the meeting itself and was put up before the committee members for evaluation.

On the basis of information contained in the comparative chart the committee observed as follows:-

"Milan Stationers, Patna" is not fulfilling the following tender criteria


- a) EMD in form of Demand Draft of Rs.1,00,000/- in favour of State Health Society, Bihar payable at Patna as tender security. This is one of the most important conditions of the tender. According to tender document it has been clearly mentioned that Any bid not accompanied by earnest money will be automatically rejected.
- b) Of having "Minimum annual turn over Rs. 10 Crore in the last three consecutive years" as it has a turn over of Rs. 0.8021 Cr. in year 2006-07, Rs. 0.8186 Cr. in 2007-08 and Rs. 0.7723 Cr. for year 2008 -09.
- c) Registration paper of the Company/Firm has not been submitted.
- d) Authorization letter of the authorizing company has not been submitted.
- e) In spite of submission of last three consecutive year's annual Audited report only two years audited report has been submitted
- f) "No. Conviction Certificate" has not been submitted.
- g) A sample of Indelible Ink Marker Pen has not been submitted.


Therefore, in the opinion of Committee "Milan Stationers, Patna does not qualify technically due to above reasons.


To certify two another important criteria of the quality test of the sample of Indelible Ink Marker Pens Sample of Marker Pen submitted by the bidders namely **Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd & Kores (India) Ltd.** handed over to Dr. Hemant Shukla RTL- NPSP (WHO), Patna, According to tender specification the two major parts of quality test are as follows: -


It will be evaluated for 2 counts


- The Indelible Ink Marker Pen should be usable for impression on **minimum 500 to 600 children per pen** under Pulse Polio Immunization Programme.
- The impression put on the finger of children should last for at least 7 days from the day of marking.

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

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
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
On 30.03.2011 the test report of quality of Indelible Ink Marker Pen & the check of Impression on minimum 500 to 600 children per pen has been submitted by RTL- NPSP(WHO), Patna (which has been annexed as Annexure – I). In the said report both firms namely **Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd & Kores (India) Ltd.** have been qualified technically.


The committee resolved that out of the total three bids, one bidder namely **Milan Stationers** has not been submitted EMD amount; hence it has already been rejected. And the rest of two bidders namely **Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd and Kores (India) Ltd.** are qualified technically. Financial Bid-Cover –B may be opened after getting approval of the concerned higher authority.


The committee resolved that the only one company/firm namely **Milan Stationers**, who was not qualified technically report should be uploaded on State Health Society, Bihar, website.


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

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

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

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
