Sub: Quality testing of Indelible Polio marker pens to be used in Pulse Polio campaign in Bihar.

Dear Sir,

This is in reference to the technical Committee Meeting on 09/05/2013 for the purchase of Indelible Marker Pens to be used in Bihar during the Pulse Polio Rounds. After reviewing the tenders, technical committee had provided us sample pens for evaluation supplied by 1 firm namely-

1. Kores (India) Ltd., New Delhi

The evaluation was conducted on 2 accounts.

- Duration for which marker pen imprint lasts.
- Number of children a pen is able to mark.

For testing the duration, marks were applied on 11/05/2013 at 7.30 am and again checked on 18/05/2013 after 9 am and further on 20/05/2013. For testing the number of children that could be marked by a pen, test was done in the field by marking the children.

The results of the test conducted are for the **sample pens only** supplied by the company along with tender documents. Evaluation results are as follows.

Till the last date for submission of tender, total three tenders were received.

Technical Bids of the bidders were opened in the meeting and cover envelops containing the technical bid as well as the bid itself was duly signed by the members and by the representative of only one bidder namely Vikrant Life Sciences Pvt. Ltd, technical bids were opened in the presence of members of technical committee & representative of and Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd.

* A Technical comparative chart was prepared in the meeting itself and was put up before the committee members for evaluation on dated 09.05.2013

On the basis of information contained in the comparative chart the committee observed as follows:-

" Rayudu Laboratories Ltd " is not fulfilling the following tender criteria

- a) Of having "Minimum annual turn over Rs. 10 Crore in the last three consecutive years" as it has a turn over of Rs. 10.55 Cr. in year 2009-10, Rs. 11.05 Cr. in 2010-11 and Rs. 06.09 Cr. for year 2011 -12.
- b) Authorization letter of the authorizing company has not been submitted.
- c) Audited report only two years audited report have been submitted, whereas requirement is for three consecutive years.

"Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd has not submitted its own Turnover & other financial reports but it has submitted these documents of M/S. Luxor Writing Instruments Pvt. Ltd, as per the Order of higher authority a request had been sent to the said bidder to submit their own Turnover & other financial documents within two days, after fresh submission of these documents it has been found that the three consecutive years Turnover are –

2009-10 : 4.79 Cr.

2010-11 : 1.23 Cr.

2011-12 : 2.92 Cr

Therefore, in the opinion of Committee **"Rayudu Laboratories Ltd.** and **"Vikrant Life Sciences (P) Ltd** are not fulfilling the last three years turnover criteria and **"Rayudu Laboratories Ltd.** have not submitted Audited report of 2011-12, hence technically due to above reasons both companies are not qualifying.

Kores, Kores(India) Limited, has been fulfilling all the technical criteria of the tender document. And there three consecutive years turnover are:-

2009-10 : 711.83Cr.

2010 -11 : 695.08 Cr.

2011 - 12: 750.36Cr.

Recommendations:-

1. KORES has been declared as technically qualified.
2. Sample of Indelible Ink Marker Pen of KORES India Ltd, which has fulfilling all the eligible criteria of Technical Bid to be sent to certify two another important criteria of the quality test of the sample of Indelible Ink Marker Pens Sample of Marker Pen submitted by the bidders namely **Kores (India) Ltd.** handed over to RTL- NPSP (WHO), Patna, According to tender specification the two major parts of quality test are as follows: -

It will be evaluated for 2 counts

- The Indelible Ink Marker Pen should be usable for impression on **minimum 500 to 600 children per pen** under Pulse Polio Immunization Programme.
- The impression put on the finger of children should last for at least 7 days from the day of marking.
