3. In response to queries raised during pre-bid meeting and submitted online as well, the technical committee recommended following modifications or clarifications:



The bidders are requested to increase/ decrease number of staff as per bed accordingly.
c)	Chapter III	Standard treatment procedures	The selected NGO shall follow the mainstream scientifically/consensually validated interventions which will not infringe on the basic Human Rights and dignity of admitted patient. Further can be specified/clarified during the agreement period as and when required.

5. Other terms and conditions of the RFP shall remain the same.



